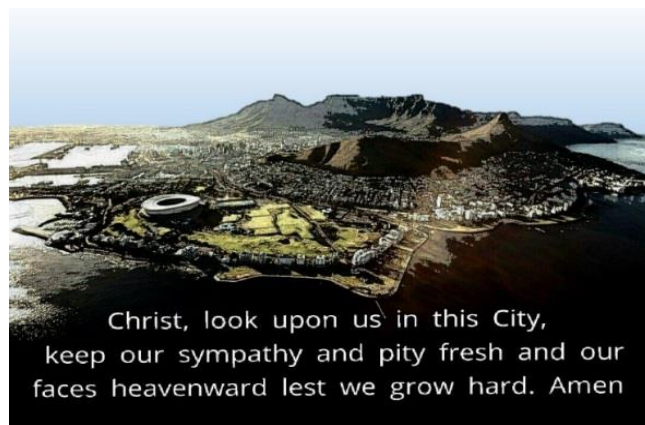

PSALM 51:1-12

- Have mercy on me, O God, in your enduring goodness: according to the fulness of your compassion blot out my offences.
- Wash me thoroughly from my wickedness: and cleanse me from my sin.**
- For I acknowledge my rebellion: and my sin is ever before me.
- Against you only have I sinned and done what is evil in your eyes: so you will be just in your sentence and blameless in your judging.**
