Notice regarding the appointment of the new Dean of St. Georges Cathedral

Dear congregants,

As you know, the application process for the new Dean of St. Georges Cathedral closed on the 31st August 2024. The process of reviewing and interviewing applicants is underway by a committee appointed by Archbishop Thabo Makgoba in accordance with the Acts of the Anglican Church of the Province of South Africa, Diocese of Cape Town, Chapter 11 (2).

In the process laid out by the Acts, the Archbishop will present a nomination for the position of the new Dean to a specially appointed Council on the 4th December 2024.

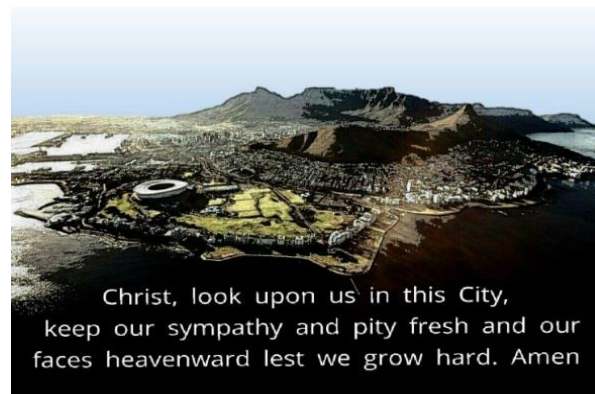
This Council has as its sole charge to accept or reject the nomination presented by the Archbishop. The Council (as per the Acts) consists of the following members:

- The Chancellor of the Cathedral, or a deputy appointed by the Archbishop – Mr. Marshall Rapiya has been appointed Chancellor by the Archbishop
- A member of Diocesan Chapter, chosen at a Chapter meeting – Ven. Terry Lester
- Two priests of the Diocese, elected by their order at each session of Diocesan Synod – Ven. Moeketsi Mototjane and Ven. Melaney Klassen
- Two Lay Communicants of the Diocese, elected by their order at each Diocesan Synod - Mrs Roslyn Moosajie and Mr. Keenan Priestley
- The two Churchwardens of the Cathedral - Ms. Nolundi Luwaya and Ms. Emma Arogundade
- Four Lay Communicants of the Cathedral elected at a meeting of the Cathedral Vestry – Ms. Avril Salo, Ms. Mary Bock, Mr. Arthur Martin, and Ms. Ayanda Malunga

The Council will consider the nomination, and convey their response to the Archbishop in writing. Once this process is complete, we will be able to announce and welcome our new Dean Designate ahead of their full investiture which is scheduled for early 2025.
