The stained-glass window located above one of the entrances to the cathedral is that of an enslaved woman, **Mama Lydia Williams**. She was born on Zonnebloem Estate in 1820 and died June 16 1910. Her mother was a Cape Creole woman and her father was a Mozambican slave. She was a founder member of St Phillip's Church in District Six and was part of the congregation on the day when Bernard Mizeki was baptised.

FOOD PARCEL MINISTRY

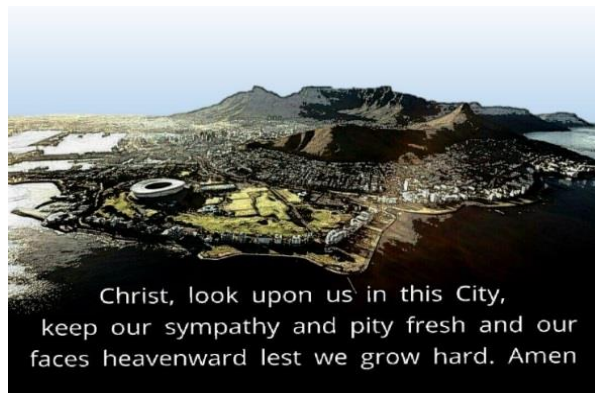
